

Carriages

Carriage for Forklift - There are 4 sizings of hook type tine carriages rated by the tine carriage lifting capacity. Hook type fork carriages have been consistent.

Class I carriages are rated for loads as much as 2000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for Class I is 13 inches. Class II carriages are rated for loads as much as 5,550 lbs. Their carriage bar spacing is 16 inches. Class III carriages are rated for cargo up to 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this particular class is 20 inches. Class IV carriages are rated for loads as much as 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this capacity is 25 inches.

Pin mounted blades vary by the amount of offset between the blade and the fork eye. Various makers will vary the carriages for pin type tines. Carriage capacity would be determined by the carriage pin size and by the tine size.
